Fees for 2012

The fees are assessed annually and the following scale was agreed at the Council meeting of 19th October 2008 in Leiden.

- Fee for National Societies: 700 Euros
- Fee for newly formed* or small societies** 350 Euros
- Fee for former communist countries now in EU 350 Euros
- Fee for former communist countries *not* in EU; 175 Euros
- Individual membership (if no national Balint Society): 70 Euros

Fees will be due on 1st March 2012

A final reminder will be sent out if the fees have not been received by 1st April 2012 and if they are not paid within the next 4 weeks, the name of the Society or Individual will be removed from the website and they will no longer be regarded as a member of the IBF.

Extract from the Minutes of the Council meeting in Israel 8th March 2008.

- * A new society is defined as one less than 3 years old.
This was agreed by the IBF Board in March 2008.
- ** A Society with more than 40 members should no longer be regarded as small and should pay the full fee (€700).
