# 2010 survey summary of findings

#### **Questionnaire sent to 22 affiliated countries:**

15 responses

**Countries which have own criteria for accreditation:** 

6, some with work in progress

## First IBF International Conference on Leadership: Copenhagen (2011)

- 45 people attended from 13 countries (28 GPs/physicians and 17 psychos)
- A groups (changing leadership)
